You will be a consistent and caring role model who works effectively in a multi-disciplinary team offering support and leadership to care staff as required.

You will always lead by example and ensure all relevant records and reports are completed accurately and within required timescales to comply with legislation, NMC guidelines and Diagrama policy.

You will also:

- Produce, implement, and review resident care plans, ensuring any changes are communicated to team members
- Monitor the delivery of care to ensure high standards are maintained
- Ensure clear communicating systems relating to clinical care are used effectively by all staff
- Promote and comply with the clinical governance framework, including participation



in the clinical audit programme as well as care planning and medicines management

- Maintain skills and knowledge to ensure care is delivered according to latest guidelines and best practice
- Create a caring and supportive environment in which residents can reach their full potential both physically and mentally
- Ensure own and, when appropriate, other's actions reduce risks to health and safety
