About the Role

This is a key role within Diagrama's Marketing and Fundraising team, focused on building the charity's fundraising capacity in a way that is sustainable, ethical, and aligned with our long-term goals. The role is primarily home-based, requiring a high degree of self-motivation, organisation and initiative. You will also travel to events and services to develop meaningful connections with our work and community.

Working closely with the Head of Marketing Strategy, you will lead the delivery of our five-year Fundraising Strategy, with clear income targets to meet and grow each year. From planning campaigns and events to writing bids and building relationships with funders, this role offers both variety and responsibility.

This is an opportunity to contribute meaningfully to a values-led organisation that is committed to changing lives. It suits someone who is proactive, purposeful, and ready to take ownership of their work in a fast-paced, mission-driven team.

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver the charity's Fundraising Strategy in partnership with the Head of Marketing.
- Develop and lead campaigns across digital, print, in-person and social media platforms.
- Plan and manage fundraising events, ensuring they are well-executed and aligned with brand values.
- Manage relationships with Patrons and Ambassadors.
- Research funding streams; write persuasive funding applications.
- Create corporate sponsorship proposals and pitch decks.
- Write clear, engaging reports for funders and donors.
- Liaise with our PR agency to support fundraising messaging.
- Oversee fundraising content on social media.
- Maintain and update fundraising pages on the website.
- Work with staff and service users to create fundraising opportunities.
- Manage supporter records on the CRM system.

- Support donation processing and stewardship.
- Identify and deliver fundraising opportunities across Fostering and Adoption services.
- Ensure all content aligns with brand values.
- Evaluate activities and report on engagement, ROI and outcomes.
- Attend fundraising events, sometimes outside standard working hours.
- Uphold health, safety and safeguarding policies.
